Proposed development at St. Thomas Estate (Phase 2) comprising the development of a single storey activities and administration building of circa 1,517m2, a single storey sprint track enclosure of circa 858m2, site landscaping including planting, seating, street furniture, fencing, berming/mounding, drainage and all ancillary works at St. Thomas Estate, Tibradden Road, Rathfarnham, Dublin 16 in proximity to a Protected Structure (St. Thomas House). A previous Part 8 was approved on the site in 2019 (PC/PKS/01/19).

In accordance with Article 42(1) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011-2021, the Planning and Development Acts 2000-2022, Article 120(1B)(i) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001-2022 and the European Union (Planning and Development) (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2018 Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made determinations following screening that:

- Appropriate Assessment is not required as the proposed, individually or in combination with other plans or projects is not likely to have a significant effect on any European sites on the basis of objective scientific information.
- There is no real likelihood of significant effects on the environment arising from the proposed development and an Environmental Impact Assessment Report is not required.

Any person may, within 4 weeks from the publication date of this notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for an EIA screening determination as to whether the proposed development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment.
