Re: PC/H/03/22 - Proposed Development at 27 Patrick Street, Dun Laoghaire, Co. <u>Dublin.</u>

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council (the Council) proposes to build 3 no. 1-bed simplex apartments and 1 no. 2-bed duplex apartments at 27 Patrick Street, Dún Laoghaire, Co. Dublin (site currently used for surface car parking). The works will also involve the construction of bicycle parking, bin storage, a reduction in the carriageway and re-profiling of the footpath for a distance of 35m along Cross Avenue, the removal of 6no. on-curtilage, surface car parking spaces and provision of 2 no. on-street parking spaces on Patrick Street

The proposal was outlined to the Elected Members of the Dún Laoghaire Area Committee at a briefing on Monday 4th July 2022. Confirmation has been received from the relevant Departments that this scheme complies with their requirements.

In accordance with S.I. No 476/2011, Planning and Development (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 2011 and S.I. No. 296/2018 European Union (Planning and Development) (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2018, the Council has carried out screenings and has determined the following:

- An Appropriate Assessment is not required.
- There is no real likelihood of significant effects on the environment so therefore the preliminary assessment has concluded that an Environmental Impact Assessment Report is not required.

Accordingly, it is recommended that the public notice procedures under Part 8 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001, as amended, be commenced.
