Environmental Impact Assessment Screening Determination in accordance with Article 120 (1B) (b)(i) of the Planning & Development Regulations, 2001 - 2018

PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT OF SITE AT Wood Park, Sallynoggin, CO. DUBLIN

PLANNING REF: PC/H/02/222


An Environmental Impact Assessment screening determination has been made by Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council in relation to an application for the residential development of a site at Wood Park, Sallynoggin, Co. Dublin.

The decision has been informed by information prepared by Traynor Environment Ltd. on behalf of the Council – Report for the Purposes of Environmental Impact Assessment Screening March 2022 - having regard to the characteristics of the proposed development, in relation to size, the cumulation with other existing development, any associated demolition works, the use of natural resources in particular land, soil, water and biodiversity, the production of waste, pollution and nuisances, surface and foul water, air and noise pollution, risk of major accident and characteristics of potential impacts.

Having reviewed and considered this Environmental Impact Assessment Screening Report and general information on the nature of the project, the Council considers that there is no real likelihood of significant effects on the environment arising from the proposed development.

Accordingly, it is determined that an EIAR is not required for this proposed development. Any Person may, within 4 weeks from the date of the site notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for an EAI screening determination as to whether the development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment.
