PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT OF AN ALL-WEATHER PITCH AT OATLANDS COLLEGE, STILLORGAN ROAD, MOUNT MERRION, BLACKROCK, CO. DUBLIN PC/PKS/02/23

In accordance with Part 8, Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations, 2001 - 2022, Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council hereby gives notice of a proposal as follows:

Proposed development of an all-weather pitch comprising earthworks & formation preparation, retaining walls, drainage, sub-base preparation, shockpad & synthetic turf, fencing & netting, ballstop netting, floodlighting, prefabricated buildings, new access steps & paths, tree & woodland planting and all ancillary civil, building and landscaping works at Oatlands College

In accordance with Article 42(1) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011-2021, the Planning and Development Acts 2000-2022, Article 120(1B) (i) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001-2022 and the European Union (Planning and Development) (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2018 Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made determinations following screening that:

- Appropriate Assessment is not required as the proposed, individually or in combination with other plans or projects is not likely to have a significant effect on any European sites on the basis of objective scientific information.
- There is no real likelihood of significant effects on the environment arising from the proposed development and an Environmental Impact Assessment Report is not required.

Any person may, within 4 weeks from the date of this notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for an EIA screening determination as to whether the development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment.
