Proposed Tennis Pavilion at Springhill Park, Mount Albany, Blackrock, Co. Dublin

The County Council's Parks Department has prepared a scheme to provide a Tennis Pavilion at Springhill Park, Mount Albany, Blackrock, Co. Dublin. This new Tennis Pavilion is proposed to replace an existing steel container, currently on site and which functions as a Club House for Newtown Park Tennis Club.


The scheme was noted at the Dún Laoghaire Area Committee on the 23rd March 2015. Confirmation has been received from the relevant Departments that this scheme complies with their requirements.

In accordance with S.I. 476, 2011, Section 250, Planning and Development (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 2011, the Council has carried out a screening and has determined that an Appropriate Assessment is not required.
