## RECORD OF EXECUTIVE BUSINESS CHIEF EXECUTIVE'S ORDERS

### Proposed development of Park and Recreational facilities at Hudson Road, Glasthule, Dún Laoghaire, Co. Dublin

The County Council's Parks Section has prepared a scheme to develop and provide a small local park and recreational facilities at the Old Presentation field on Hudson Road. This Part 8 will further develop the old sports grounds to include upgraded pitches, changing rooms, a park path network, local play lot, outdoor exercise equipment, seating and boules area.

The scheme was noted at the Dún Laoghaire Area Committee Meeting on the 27<sup>th</sup> June 2016. Confirmation has been received from the relevant Department that this scheme complies with their requirements.

In accordance with S.I. 476, 2011, Section 250, Planning and Development (Amendment) (No.3) Regulations, 2011, the Council has carried out a screening and has determined that an Appropriate Assessment is not required.

Accordingly, I recommend that the public notice procedures under part 8 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 as amended be commenced.
