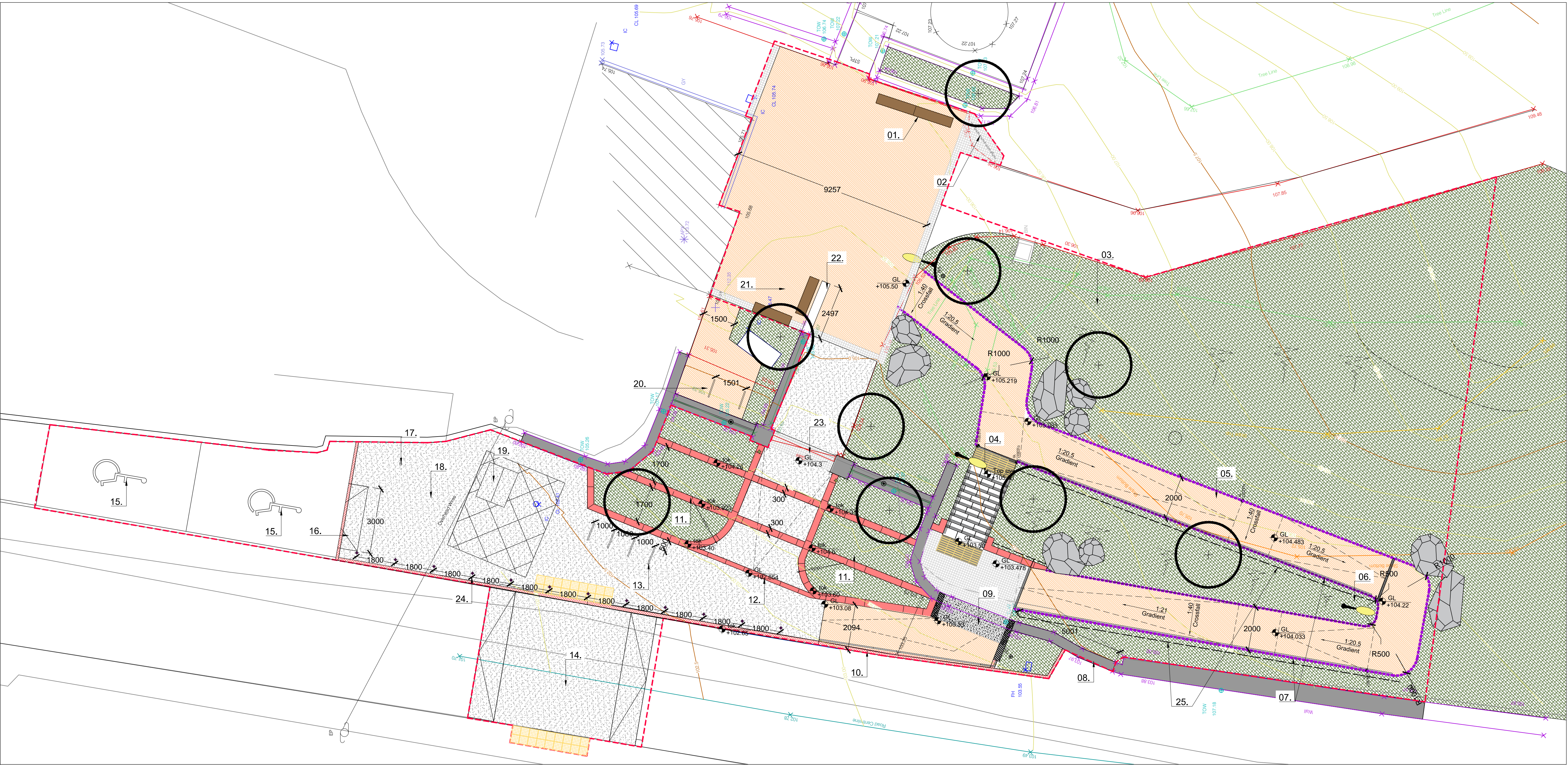


1. 2No. Seats with back & armrests
2. Existing Park signage relocated with Granite sett paving beneath.
3. Working area to be cleared of vegetation. Area to be regraded locally to marry sloped access into embankment.
4. Stepped access with handrails and cordroy hazard paving to top and bottom of steps.
5. 2m wide gentle sloped access to Part M Building Regulations.
6. 4m high standard lighting column.
7. Handrail on western side of footpath.
8. 5m length of existing wall capping shall be cleared of vegetation and repaired and repointed .
9. New reconstituted stone gateway structure to be installed and random rubble granite reinstated to butt up to structure.
10. New road kerb.
11. Terrace planters.
12. Feature stone banding.
13. 4No. cycle racks.
14. Existing traffic calming table to be altered to create an accessible crossing.
15. Disabled parking bay.
16. Drop kerb.
17. Remove existing pole.
18. Break out existing brick kerb and resurface arrival area.
19. Existing Gas access chamber to be left unaltered.
20. 2No. cargo bike parking racks.
21. Seating space.
22. Extend stone retaining wall .
23. Feature sett paving threshold.
24. Drop bollards sockets to allow for further car parking control if necessary.
25. 100mm perforated PVC filter drain.
