

DECLARATION OF AREAS TO BE MADE PUBLIC

In accordance with the provisions of Section 180 of the Planning & Development Act, 2000 (as amended) and Section 11 of the Roads Act, 1993 (as amended), Dún Laoghaire - Rathdown County Council hereby gives notice of its intention to consider the making of a declaration that may include open space, roads, footpaths, public lighting, surface water sewer, foul sewer and watermains at the following locations to be made public;

- **St. Helen's Wood, Booterstown. Co. Dublin**
- **Stanford Park, Foxrock, Dublin 18**

Maps showing the areas may be inspected at the Planning Counter, Level 1, County Hall, Dún Laoghaire during office hours 10.00 am – 4.00 pm (including lunchtime) on weekdays from 7th of March 2024 to 22nd of April 2024 inclusive.
