

DECLARATION OF AREAS TO BE MADE PUBLIC

In accordance with the provisions of Section 180 of the Planning & Development Act, 2000 and Section 11 of the Roads Act, 1993 (as amended), Dún Laoghaire - Rathdown County Council hereby gives notice of its intention to consider the making of a declaration that may include roads, footpaths, public lighting, playground, foul sewer, surface water sewer and watermains at the following locations to be made public;

- **Oatlands Manor, Mount Merrion, Blackrock, Co. Dublin.**
- **Proby Place, Blackrock, Co. Dublin.**
