

REPORT ON THE DEVELOPMENT PROPOSED FOR TAKING IN CHARGE

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council is now in a position to take in charge the open space, roads, footpaths, public lighting, surface water sewer, foul sewer and watermains at:

Neptune House, Blackrock, Co. Dublin

Planning permission was granted in 2015 under planning reference: PL06D.245340 (D15A/0286). This development consisted of the demolition of the annex to Neptune House, modifications to house to include 4 apartments and construction of 13 houses on the site. The Taking in Charge drawing relating to this development (Drawing Number BC-1795-TIC-01) indicates the areas to be taken in charge and the areas to remain private. A copy of this drawing is attached for reference.

Each of our service departments have checked this development and are satisfied for the development to proceed to taking in charge as set out below-

- Water Services (Surface Water)
- Public Lighting
- Road Maintenance
- Parks Department

Irish Water have also confirmed that the Council can proceed to take this development in charge in relation to the foul sewer and Water infrastructure. When Taken-in-Charge is completed, the Foul Sewer and Watermain will be maintained by Irish Water, while the Surface Water Sewer will be maintained by Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council.

Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council now invite members of the public to make objections or representations in relation to the proposed taking in charge of this development.
