Proposed Cherrywood Green Routes Network, Cherrywood SDZ

Notice of Part 8 Planning Procedure

Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended)

Dir was successful in its application in respect of the Cherrywood Public Parks, Greenways and Attenuation Project under Call 1 of the Urban Regeneration Development Fund (URDF) with funding secured for the entire project in June 2020 for €17.81M. This funding is by way of 75% direct government funding and 25% funded through a combination of Cherrywood Section 48 Development Contributions and funding from the National Transport Authority (NTA). The project comprises 4 distinct sub-projects of which the Green Routes Network within the Linear Park is one.

The Green Routes Network is the 'spine' of the Cherrywood Green Infrastructure network which will connect walking/cycling routes and open spaces in the wider area. The Green Routes Network is central to the Cherrywood Planning Scheme which sets challenging targets for sustainable travel modes and identifies measures for achieving them.


The Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown Elected Members were briefed on this scheme in advance of the Dún Laoghaire (HEPI) Area Committee meeting on 9th June 2021.

Accordingly, I recommend that the public notice procedures under Part 8 of the planning and development Regulations (2001) be commenced.


