DÚN LAOGHAIRE-RATHDOWN COUNTY COUNCIL PARKING CONTROL (AMENDMENT) BYE-LAWS, 2025 Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1994, Section 36 of the Road Traffic Act 1994 and Section 101 of the Road Traffic Act 1961 and having consulted with the Commissioner of An Garda Síochána hereby makes the following Bye-Laws.

PART I Preliminary

Citation:

 These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council Parking Control (Amendment) Bye-Laws, 2025.

Commencement:

2. These Bye-Laws shall come into operation on the

Area of Application:

- These Bye-Laws apply to the area comprising of the administrative area of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council.
- 4. The Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council Parking Control Bye Laws, 2020 and these Bye-Laws may be cited together as the Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council Parking Control Bye-Laws, 2020 2025.
- 5. The Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council Parking Control Bye-Laws, 2020 is amended to provide as follows: -

At Bye-Law 9 – Appropriate Parking Fees / Manner and time of payment of parking fee

Shall be amended by inserting Bye-Law 9 (e)

"Pursuant to its powers, the Council reserves the right to review the Parking Fees set out in the Bye-Laws and to amend them by way of Council resolution."

At Bye-Law 11 - Suspension of paid parking controls on specified days:

Shall be amended by the substitution of the following Bye-Law for Bye-Law 11

"Paid parking controls shall not apply in any paid parking area on the following days:

New Year's Day 1st January

St. Brigid's Day First Monday of February,

or 1st February if that date

falls on a Friday

St. Patrick's Day 17th March

Easter Monday Variable

May Public Holiday First Monday of May

June Public holiday First Monday of June

August Public holiday First Monday of August

October Public Holiday Last Monday of October

Christmas Day 25th December St. Stephen's Day 26th December."

<u>At Bye-Law 21 – Issue of, and fee for parking</u> <u>permit</u>

Shall be amended by inserting Bye-Law 21 (d)

"Pursuant to its powers, the Council reserves the right to review the Parking Fees set out in the

Bye-Laws and to amend them by way of Council resolution."

<u>At Bye-Law 30 – Issue of, and fee for visitor parking</u> <u>permit</u>

Shall be amended by inserting Bye-Law 30 (c)

"Pursuant to its powers, the Council reserves the right to review the Parking Fees set out in the Bye-Laws and to amend them by way of Council resolution."
